Summer Assignment

There are three parts to the Summer Assignment for Dr. Yaceczko's Medieval Latin class. The first two are concerned with **morphology**. One is for verbs (to be conjugated); the other is for demonstratives, adjectives, and nouns (to be declined).

1. Verbs. Do six verb synopses: one for each person and number combination. You must choose verbs from the following list, and write them into the chart below:

2. Demonstrative-Adjective-Noun. Do five DANs. An example of a DAN of the phrase **haec pulchra civitas, this beautiful city**, is included in this packet. You must choose from the following phrases:

- every word itself: *omne verbum ipse*
- that coming glory: *illa gloria veniens*
- a certain baptizing prophet: *quidam propheta baptizans*
- this spirit that is descending: *hic spiritus descendens*
- the same true Israelite: *idem verus Israelita*
- this written law: *ea scripta lex*
